Announces the 2010 GRANT Awards

The Board of Directors was truly blessed with growth last year in the Iva Haraway Fund that motivated The Foundation to fund \$13,797. An additional amount of \$7,963 remaining from prior year grants and also \$1,000 from the James and Annette Furr Philmont Scholarship Fund for a total of \$22,760 is awarded to the Ministry areas of the Church and the Community. The Board voted unanimously to award funds to support the local church in the accomplishment of its religious, charitable, benevolent, and educational goals. The grants have been awarded on the basis of an application process to the following groups:

- FUMC Youth/Whitewater Cove – \$3,500 - Youth Summer Retreat in Transylvania Co. Youth and adults will provide labor for Phase I of Whitewater Cove's renovation project
- FUMC Youth Ministry – \$2,000 – Creating a more welcoming, worshipful space equipped with technology to enhance Jr. High programming
- Kairos Prison Ministry - \$400 – Four-day weekend at Leath Correctional Institution in Greenwood, SC to introduce Christ to forty-two residents and also set up beginnings of Prayer & Share group within the Center
- Mission/Outreach - \$6,500 – Providing funds for Christian Mission Service to an orphanage in Puebla, Mexico and residences of Willow, AK and Fran Lynch, one of the missionaries supported by FUMC
- Bread of Life - \$1,000 – Emergency Pantry Box Program providing additional take-out containers for clients
- FUMC Worship - \$1,000 – Purchase digital recording equipment for production of CDs for those who request the recordings
- WCP - \$860 – Purchase a playhouse for Toddler Playground
- The Free Clinic - \$2,500 – Purchase an Automated External Defibrillator for use in case of traumatic cardiac event
- FUMC Trustees - \$2,000 – Enhancing the performance reliability of existing computer systems by replacing with current technology
- Meals on Wheels - \$2,000 – Continuing services in light of continuing recession and increased number of clients
- Daniel Boone Council, Boy Scouts of America - \$1,000 from The Jim and Annette Furr Philmont Ranch Scholarship Fund
