

## THE ORGAN

First United Methodist Church Chapel  
Brevard, North Carolina

The organ in the chapel of the First United Methodist Church is a two-manual tracker pipe organ built by the Kinzey-Angerstein Organ Company of Wrentham, Massachusetts. The organ was built in 1977 for Donna Nagey Robertson, Professor of Music, Mars Hill College and installed in her home in Mars Hill, NC. In 2005 Mrs. Robertson donated the organ to Brevard First United Methodist Church for installation in the chapel. Daniel Angerstein, builder of the organ relocated the instrument to FUMC in July of that year. Mrs. Robertson presented the dedicatory recital on October 16, 2005.
